All articles must be produced and grown by the Exhibitor. If the Judge deems articles have been purchased for exhibition, they will be disqualified. After being entered, the superintendent is in control of the exhibits: Exhibitors shall not interfere with, or handle exhibits afterwards.

No entries will be released before 5:00 PM on Sunday, July 19. If you are unable to pick up your exhibits at the release time, it is your responsibility to find someone to do so. Any items remaining after 6:00 PM on Sunday, July 19 will be disposed of immediately. **Spoiled Produce will be disqualified.**
